is available for people who have held General Radiotelephone Operator, First Class or Second Class licenses from the Federal Communications Commission, as a result of having passed the Commission's qualifying testing procedures for such licenses. To receive your Certificate of Competency, which measures 8½ by 11 inches on heavy certificate paper, send \$10 and a photocopy of your most recent license from the FCC. Additionally, if you have held a valid First Class FCC Radiotelephone License, submit a photocopy of that and we will affix a gold, embossed "First Class" sticker on the certificate.
